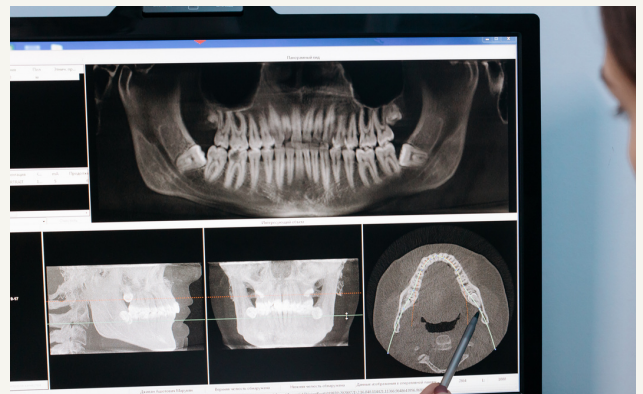
Your dentist will spend time talking with you about your dental history, any concerns you may have and what you would like to achieve with your dental care.

If necessary, digital X-rays may be taken to assess areas that cannot be seen during a standard examination.

Anxious Or Worried?

You're not alone. Many people feel nervous about visiting the dentist, especially if it has been a while since their last appointment or if they have had difficult experiences in the past.

At The Kurmond Dentist, we understand these concerns and take a gentle, supportive approach to care. Our team takes the time to listen, explain everything clearly and ensure you feel comfortable throughout your visit.

If you are feeling anxious, please let us know. We are always happy to move at a pace that feels right for you, answer any questions you may have and make sure you feel relaxed before we begin.

For many patients, simple comforts can make a big difference. You are welcome to watch your favourite show on the ceiling-mounted TVs during your appointment, we will even provide noise-cancelling headphones to listen comfortably while we work.

If dental treatment still feels overwhelming, we can also discuss additional options to help you feel more at ease. These may include anxiety-management medications or treatment with the support of an experienced IV sedationist.

Our goal is to create a calm and welcoming environment where you feel supported and confident in taking care of your oral health.

YOUR QUESTIONS ANSWERED

Frequently Asked Questions

Q1. Will it hurt?

Our approach is gentle. We take the time to ensure you are comfortable during your visit. Most treatments are far more comfortable than patients expect and we can always take additional steps to help your comfort.

Q2. How long will it take?

Most adult new patient appointments take around 60 minutes. This allows time for a thorough examination, clean and a personalised discussion about your oral health. If treatment is needed, we'll provide a clear plan outlining appointment times and what to expect.

Q3. It's been a long time, will I be judged?

Not at all. We understand that life gets busy and many patients feel the same way. Our role is simply to help you move forward in a way that feels comfortable and manageable, without judgement.

Payment Options

Health Funds

We accept all major health funds and offer on-the-spot claiming through HICAPS, allowing you to claim your rebate immediately at the time of your appointment.

Orthodontic Plans

For orthodontic treatments such as braces or clear aligners, we offer in-house payment plans to help make treatment more manageable over time.

Government Programs

We accept DVA and Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS) for eligible patients.

Payment Plans

For patients who prefer to spread the cost of treatment, we also offer a range of payment solutions including Zip Pay and Afterpay.
